



Saud Al Mualla, “ 12 Years Of Development And Construction In Umm Al Quwain”

Umm Al Quwain has been destined for historic transformation and a new developmental turn that builds its future and consolidates its past, when His Highness Sheikh Saud Bin Rashid Al Mualla took over the reins of power in the Emirate, supported by the Supreme Council of the Union, to start work and achievements, and launch a renewable era of development, construction, and modernization throughout the Emirate. That was in consistent and integrated with the country's plans and programs, and in line with the comprehensive and sustainable development projects in the other Emirates, where the past 12 years have witnessed a radical transformation in various fields. His Highness, The Ruler of Umm Al Quwain, has a great record of successes that have been guided by him in steady and accurate steps. Since His Highness was the Crown Prince, he used to draw and plan the future of the promising Emirate, starting his political career in various positions that contributed to the formation of a comprehensive development vision of the Emirate, where he could lead progress of Umm Al Quwain to be with the other Emirates through the process of growth, progress and prosperity. Umm Al Quwain has witnessed a package of comprehensive development projects that have enhanced its geographical position in the middle of the other Emirates, in addition to the humanitarian projects represented by Sheikh Saud Bin Rashid Al Mualla Foundation for Charitable and Humanitarian Works, and many infrastructure projects such as the wide roads, schools, hospitals, and universities. Umm Al Quwain is proceeding confidently to achieve distinction in all economic, social and service fields, through a package of new development constructed in various regions of the Emirate, in addition to several projects that benefit fishermen, including ice and al Gargour manufacturers, and Al-Maidan port has been developed to include more than 350 fishermen in the emirate. Umm Al Quwain government has given a big importance to

providing a decent life for citizens and residents in the emirate under the directives of His Highness the Ruler of Umm Al Quwain. Sheikh Saud bin Rashid Al Mualla Charitable and Humanitarian Works Foundation which was established based on the instructions of His Highness is the best proof of providing aid to low-income persons, in addition to establishing housing. Coinciding with the state's celebrations of the 49th National Day and in continuation of the projects and initiatives of Saud bin Rashid Al Mualla Foundation for Charitable and Humanitarian Works, the Foundation began implementing a residential area of 78 houses in Al Salama under the name “Tolerance District 2”, which will be completed during the first quarter of 2022. Its cost is 50 million dirhams, and it is the second residential project implemented by the Foundation in Umm Al Quwain, with 52593 square meters. The project is located next to the «Tolerance District 1». It includes unified residential models in terms of size and architectural style in addition to a mosque over an area of 425 meters Square and shops over an area of 510 square meters. The project also includes a sewage treatment plant to serve the residential district. The foundation has also completed a project to establish a sewage treatment plant in the Al-Shas area at a cost of 350 thousand dirhams, and a capacity of 15,000 gallons per day. Umm Al Quwain has witnessed several infrastructure projects that have been implemented by the Ministry of Infrastructure Development in cooperation with the Department of Urban Planning and Municipalities in the Emirate, where 5 new road projects have been implemented in various regions of Umm Al Quwain, with a length of 40 km, and cost of about 92 million dirhams during the last period. These roads are part of the vital projects implemented by the government in order to facilitate the movement of citizens and residents in the emirate, and to achieve smooth movement in internal and external roads to provide safety and security for road users. The most prominent road is Al Marifa Street with a length of 2.5 km. The department also is working on 6.5 km long streets in the Al-Qarain area, where 70% of the project that serves residential and commercial areas has been completed. The project is scheduled to be performed next March, in addition to the Al Muddar roundabout behind Umm Al Quwain Bank, which has clearly contributed to facilitating traffic movement in the area. The Ministry is working on other projects in Umm Al Quwain, including the civil defence building in the emirate. It has also started the first phase of the expansion and development of the Maidan Marina in Umm Al Quwain at a cost of 82 million dirhams, which includes burying the eastern side of the port with a length of 700 meters from the beach to the depths, as well as the western side of the beach to the inside with a length of 700 meters, that is, the two sides will be buried by approximately 7 meters. The aim of the filling process is to change the main entrance of the port and expand its internal part to facilitate the entry and exit of boats. The first phase includes adding 140 new berths, 100 berths are for small and large boats, and 40 berths for large establishments of different sizes, starting from 38 feet and above, up to 40 and 45 feet, which will greatly facilitate the work of fishermen. The number of berths in the port will reach 440. In order to improve and develop health services, Umm Al Quwain government, under the directives of His Highness Sheikh Saud bin Rashid Al Mualla, has completed the construction and demolition waste treatment plant in Al-Madfaq area, which was supervised by DulSCO. Umm Al Quwain landfill project, implemented by the Ministry of Climate Change and Environment, costs 11.8 million dirhams, as a pre-emptive

preparation for the treatment and rehabilitation of the main landfill project in the city, where the current contractor will start the targeted main stage, which will include a comprehensive treatment of the current landfill, which is used to dispose of the waste generated in the emirate. Saud bin Rashid Al Mualla Award for Excellence in Governmental Performance launched by His Highness, which is the first of its kind in the emirate, focuses on innovation as the new dimension of strategic performance, and it is an effective and long-term means in achieving sustainable and competitive benefit. Institutions need to adopt proactive strategies to achieve Leadership in all fields and get the award. This award shows how the country is keen to provide an attractive, creative environment calls for innovation which is the symbol of the Emirates. Through these awards, creative environment, that contributes to creating new innovations, can be created. As part of the program "by science, we go up", which is being held by Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum Humanitarian &



Charity Est aiming to provide support to the educational process within the country, help students, and provide the necessary educational means, the Foundation distributed laptops to Umm Al Quwain university students, in the context of the Foundation's keenness to provide the necessary educational means for needy students

That was stated by Saleh Zahir Saleh, Director of the Foundation at the ceremony held in AlltiHAD Hall in Umm Al Quwain, in the presence of Dr. Galal Hatem, President of Umm Al Quwain University, to distribute laptops to some of the needy university students. He added that the Foundation has been

He said that the mechanism of distributing these devices to needy students after they were counted by the university and sent attached with statements to the establishment for approval.

He emphasized that, these tests measure the extent to which students possess basic and legal skills that qualify them for the labour market. Students will do the test at university campus.

UAQU Succeeds in the Experience of Conducting Fall 20/21 Final Exams on campus

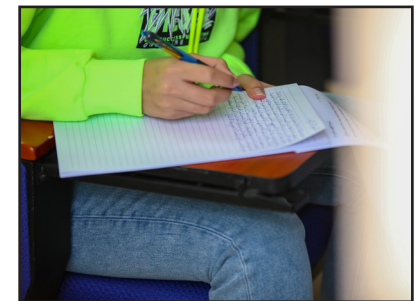

Symposium on E-Publishing Laws at Umm Al Quwain University, The UAE Has Been A Pioneer in The Field of Organizing Media Activity, And Enact Laws to Combat Cybercrime

Umm Al Quwain University organized a webinar on publishing laws and cyber-crime in the United Arab Emirates, in the presence of Dr. Galal Hatem, President of the University, Dr. Hani Bakr, Vice President for Academic



Affairs, and Deans of the colleges. A group of academic and administrative members, students, and guests participated in the webinar.

Dr. Haitham al-Samarrai, Dean of the College of Mass Communication, said that the technological developments in our time have made social media sites accessible to millions of people, and the statistics during this year has shown that the number of social media accounts are considered as one of the most active accounts where more than 32 million accounts have been recorded at the level of the United Arab Emirates. YouTube came at the forefront of these sites with more than 8 million users, then Facebook with more than 7 million users, and thirdly, Instagram with more than 6 million users, and the fourth is Twitter with more than 5 million users, finally LinkedIn with more than 4 million users.

Dr. Al-Samarrai stressed the importance of educating young people, especially university and school students regarding the positive use of these social websites, referring to the tweet of His Highness Sheikh

Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum - may God protect him - about the call to stop chaos and the negative use of social websites, and the standards that he called for the necessity of commitment In



terms of establishing social responsibility and strengthening patriotism - and self-control to repositioning in this area.

Dr. Ayman Al-Khasawneh, legal advisor at the National Media Council, spoke about the press, publishing and electronic publishing laws in the UAE. He said that the UAE has chosen the principle of organizing media, as it is the appropriate model, referring to UAE society that is considered a media-rich society, where the media industry is witnessing a huge development. Al Kasawneh added that media legislation in the country has prioritized the freedom of media and expression, and not to impose restrictions in this field and to support the electronic and digital media industry, in order to keep pace with media scientific developments, and to preserve the UAE's tremendous achievements at the global level.

Al-Khasawneh added that the process of organizing media and e-publishing in the

that there are principles and charters that must be adhered to in the digital content field such as presenting positive opinions, leaving comments to specialists, respecting the privacy of others, being truthful and honest, avoiding rumours and misleading news, respecting religions, stressing that the UAE is a state of tolerance and moderation.

For his part, Dr. Abdulghani Qasim, Dean of the College of Law, said that the UAE has been a pioneer in the field of developing

legislation organizing media work, especially in the field of social websites and combating cybercrime, as it has set legislation and penalties for misuse of these means, especially the Anti-Cyber Crime Law of 2012

Which criminalized insulting, defamation, assaulting the privacy of others. He said that the legislator has criminalized illegal access to websites and criminalized damaging network. He also criminalized dirty channels, indicating that the laws related to this issue has stated the penalty of imprisonment and a fine which may reach 250 thousand dirhams and not exceed 500 thousand dirhams.

Dr. Abdul-Ghani added that young people and students shall be aware of the negative uses of social media, noting that the UAE has tightened penalties in the field of combating cybercrime.

Dr. Galal Hatem, President of Umm Al Quwain University, announced the university's adoption of the Professional Honour Charter proposed by the legal consultant in order to work on raising awareness and education in the field of publishing and the positive use of social websites at the level of the United Arab Emirates. Jumana added that there are many skills must be available in program presenters and broadcasters, in particular, the skills of presenting ideas through technology,

whether traditional or new media, as well as personality or charisma indicating that this characteristic is born with a person and develops if interest in developing it. She said that among those specifications and skills the decent appearance, which must be reasonable without exaggeration or negligence, as simplicity is the appropriate form for broadcasters and program presenters, in addition to the arts of performance, visual communication, body language and other speed and pitch of sound, beside cutting sentences and pauses beside the etiquette of dialogue and conversation,

and good listening to others. Miss Jumana emphasized the importance of mastering the language used in communicating the media message in terms of rules, fundamentals, expressions and others.
