



Outstanding Faculty Research Award

Criteria for selection of the outstanding faculty research:

1. The criteria for selecting the outstanding faculty research includes the following areas, books, research articles, conference presentations; research guidance, research awards and honors, and funded research projects.
2. The award covers all the works that have been achieved since 2019. Research activities that have been published since joining UAQU will be accepted.
3. Applicants for the award shall complete the participation form with their research achievements within the stipulated timeline along with all supporting documents

4. Scoring criteria:

- a) **3 Scores** per **book** published with ISBN. Number of books shall not exceed 5 (15 Scores).
 - b) **5 scores** per **research published** in peer-reviewed journal. Number of articles shall not exceed 5 (25 Scores, 4 for publications in peer-reviewed journals and 1 for the ones published in journals indexed in Scopus,).
 - c) **3 scores** per paper presentations in **international conferences**. Number of presentations shall not exceed 5 (15 Scores).
 - d) **2 scores** research paper presentations in **national/ regional conferences**. Number of presentations shall not exceed 5 (15 Scores). Number of presentations shall not exceed 5 (10 Scores).
 - e) **2 scores** per **research supervision** of Ph.D. and Master Degrees students. Number of research works shall not exceed 5 (10 scores). Ongoing research students will not be considered.
 - f) **2 scores** per **research award/honor/recognition**. **Number of awards shall not exceed 5 (10 scores)**.
 - g) **3 scores** per **funded research project**. **Number of projects shall not exceed 5 (15 scores)**.
5. Application forms that are not attached with supporting documents shall not be accepted.
 6. The **minimum required score** to apply for the award is **15 scores**.
 7. Research Committee, chaired by UAQU Chancellor, decides the outstanding faculty research.
